Dear Parent / Guardian,

As you know the examinations are well underway for Year 11 students and in some cases students have now completed most of the subjects that they were studying. In order to maximise the study time for students in the run up to their final examinations we will adopt the following arrangements from **Monday 12<sup>th</sup> June**.

- 8.15** All Year 11 Students must arrive at the academy every day, as per normal, by 8.15 am
- 8.20** There will be a range of intervention and revision sessions in the main hall for students in order to help them prepare for upcoming examinations.
- 8.45** Students who have an examination will be escorted to the exams hall in the TA centre.

Students will be dismissed from the TA centre at the end of each examination.

These arrangements are for **all** students for **all** remaining examinations with the exception of those students sitting the **History Paper 2** on the afternoon of **Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> June**. History students will be released from the academy following their Chemistry Paper in the morning, but are required to be **lined up at the TA centre gates no later than 1.15 pm**.

The academy will continue to conduct revision sessions for subjects with examinations remaining. We will communicate the details of these separately.
