It will also be an opportunity where we can outline our expectations of how we expect your child to approach the year ahead, so that they can be successful throughout.

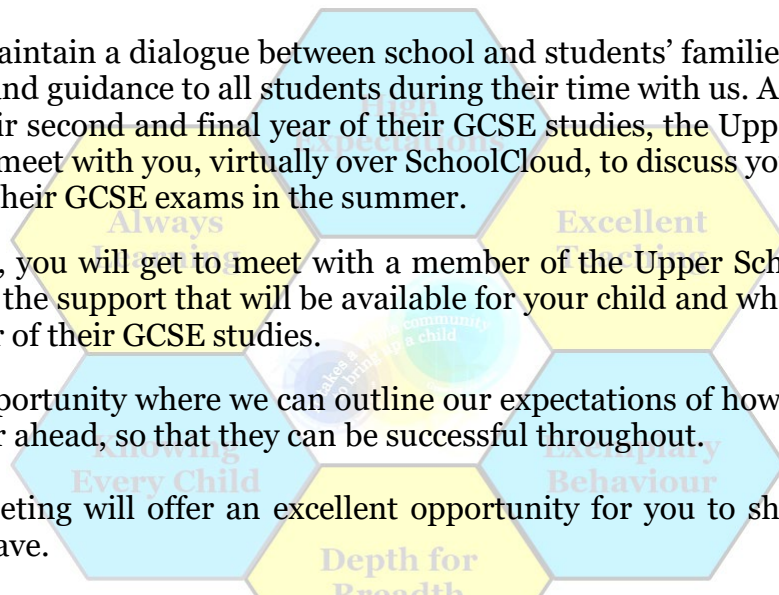
In addition, the meeting will offer an excellent opportunity for you to share any questions or concerns that you have.
