Dear Parent/Carer,

SPARK is an online remote learning platform created by subject experts across Ark. It is designed to consolidate and extend your child’s learning remotely. Your child can access SPARK through our school’s website. This can also be found on the timetable below for your convenience. Simply click on the link, go to ‘Year Groups’ found on the top left and select your year group and find the subjects listed below.
