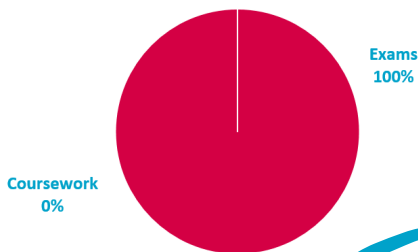


Why choose Professional Pathways?

Most students who choose Professional Pathways have an average grade of 5 in their GCSEs.

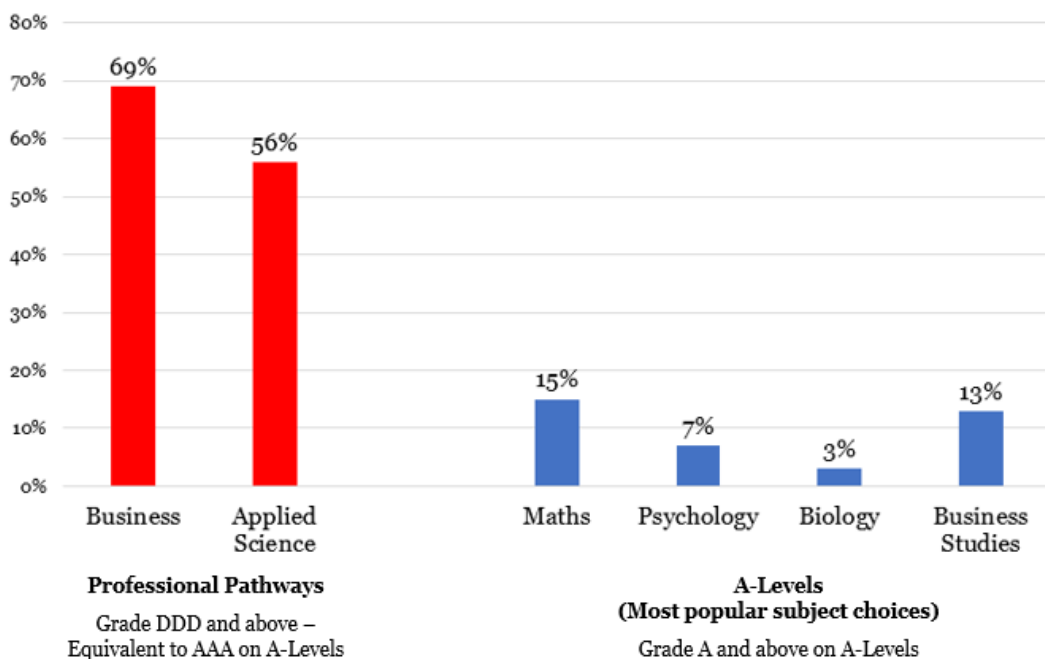
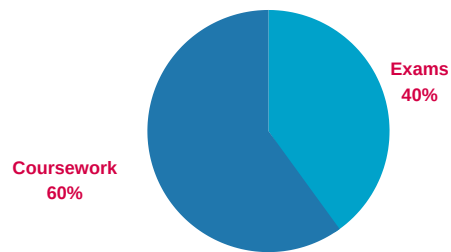
These students have the potential to achieve top grades on a Professional Pathways programme, which they might not on an A-Level course.
